Stop by for a walk and see for yourself the land you've helped to protect!

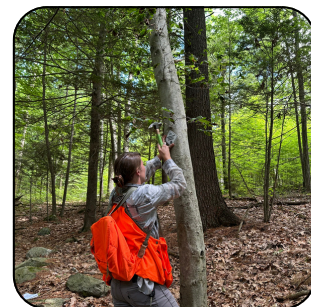

Keeping Protected Land Safe

To protect the land and the wildlife that call it home, every conserved property has a unique set of rules prohibiting certain activities such as constructing new buildings, removing plants or trees, or using motorized vehicles. Opacum is responsible for regularly monitoring protected land and identifying violations of these rules. If violations are found, Opacum takes steps to address them and to keep the land safe.
